

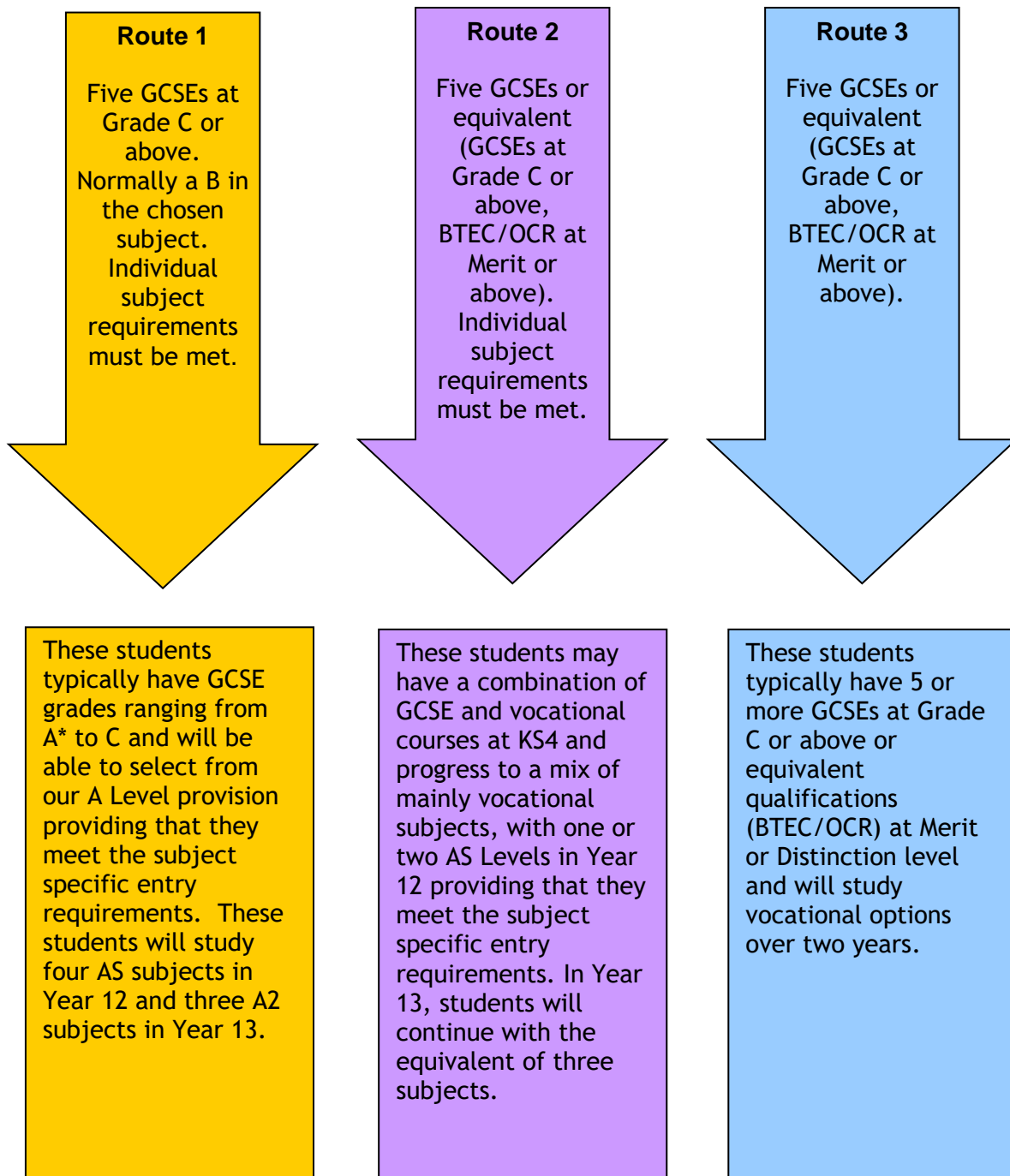

Sixth Form Pathways

We provide three kinds of courses at Christ the King Sixth Form Centre - A Levels, Applied A Levels and BTECs. These are offered in varying combinations to form three pathways. The course you choose will be based upon your individual strengths, your interests and aptitudes and your intentions for your future. Your individual pathway will largely be determined by your examination results.

All Pathways will have the opportunity to enhance their curriculum provision through studying General RE, attending Guidance sessions and by selecting appropriate options from our Year 13 Enrichment programme, which includes AS/A2 General Studies, CoPE and the Level 3 Extended Project.

Additionally, any student without a grade C at GCSE in Maths and/or English will be required to attend re-sit lessons as part of their provision.

Entry Requirements

The expected requirement for an AS Level subject is grade B at GCSE in the equivalent subject. In the case of subjects that are not studied at GCSE, a grade B in a related subject is expected in its place. There are a few subjects where a grade C may be accepted from an applicant with a proven aptitude in that subject. These subjects include:

- Art
- Design Technology
- Fashion and Textiles
- Film Studies
- Food, Nutrition and Health (Home Economics)
- Health and Social Care (Applied)
- ICT (Applied)
- Media Studies
- Performing Arts
- Photography
- Resistant Materials

Further Mathematics requires a grade A in Maths GCSE and can only be studied in conjunction with Maths A Level.

All applicants to Christ the King Sixth Form will have two individual interviews; one following the application deadline and the second on enrolment.
