**Consultation on Admissions Policies for September 2022**

The Governing Body of Christ the King Catholic High School and Sixth Form Centre is consulting on proposed changes to their admissions policy to take effect for school admissions for September 2022. Specifically, it is proposed to reduce the published admission number of the school from 180 to 150 with effect from September 2022.

This would only have implications for new applications for Year 7 class places from September 2022 onwards and children in other year groups and who have already obtained a place at the school will not experience any changes.
