**HISTORY DEPARTMENT**

The History Department has three full-time members of staff and further input into teaching History is provided by other qualified members of staff.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach across the ability range from Key Stage 3 to Key Stage 4. At Key Stage 3 pupils are taught in sets.

Year 7 have four lessons a fortnight, where they are taught the Romans and Medieval Realms 1066–1500.

Year 8 have four lessons a fortnight. They study Britain 1500 – 1750, Britain 1750 – 1900 and Black Peoples of America.

Year 9, 10 and 11 follow the Edexcel specification, where they have four lessons a fortnight.

At Key Stage 5 the department follows AQA specification 1L and 2 D.

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
