This document has been produced by Ofqual and contains some useful information on how grades were calculated, information on appeals processes, the autumn exam series as well as a question and answer section that I'm sure you will all find useful. We hope this booklet will answer many of the questions that you may have, but if you need any help at all, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Appeals:

The student document enclosed in the envelope details the grounds on which an appeal can be made. Be aware that grounds for appeal are limited (you cannot make an appeal just because you think you should have got a higher grade, or you do not agree with the grades you have been given – see enclosed booklet) and should be discussed with the school in the first instance. If you feel you have grounds to appeal, please contact Miss Magill (Exams Officer) via email – magilln@christtheking-school.com and we will look into the matter for you and forward you any forms needed to make the appeal, but this will only happen if we feel there is a case for an appeal. If you need any further information regarding the process for appeals, please email Miss Magill (Exams Officer).

Summer 20 Internal appeals forms must be submitted by **Thursday 3rd September 2020**. This deadline is earlier than the final deadline as this will give us time to investigate the claim and make any necessary requests to the exam board by the final deadline of **Thursday 17th September 2020**

Entries for the autumn 2020 series:

As you are all aware there will be an autumn exam series taking place in October (AS and A Level) / November (GCSE) this year. This is primarily for students that feel that they want to improve on the Centre Assessed Grades (CAGs) that have been awarded. If you would like to enter yourself for exams in the autumn exam series please email or speak to Miss Magill (Exams Officer) – magilln@christtheking-school.com with the request and the relevant forms / information will be forwarded on to you. Please be aware that if you enter yourself, you will have to take all exams for that subject. You cannot just take one exam if there are 3 exams for that subject, you need to sit all 3 (or however many there are for that subject).

Deadlines for entries for this series are as follows:

AS & A Level = 4th September 2020

GCSEs except in English and Maths = 18th September 2020

GCSEs in English and Maths = 4th October 2020
