Personal Appearance and Uniform



All pupils in Years 7 to 11 are required to wear full school uniform, as agreed by the School's Governing Body. The cooperation of parents/guardians in providing the correct items as described is essential towards achieving this.

The following is applicable to both boys and girls:

- Hair should be its natural colour and worn in an off the face style. Any pupil whose hair obscures their face will be required to tie it back.
- No extremes of fashion in cut, style or colour are acceptable. Short hair must not be cut shorter than 'grade 2'.
- Make-up and nail polish are not permitted.
- No jewellery may be worn with the exception of a wristwatch and/or a small pair of studs in pierced ear lobes.



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- Double studs, facial piercing, tongue piercing et al are NOT permitted. Any pupil with a piercing of this type will be required to remove it IMMEDIATELY.
- Any form of baseball/trucker type caps are NOT to be worn.
- Any form of hooded sweatshirt/jackets are NOT to be worn.

Girls Uniform

- Black blazer with school badge.
- Black jumper with school crest, NO other jumpers or cardigans are permitted.
- Mid-grey knee-length or longer skirt OR black tailored trousers. (Football shorts or similar should NOT be worn under skirts. If the skirt is of the appropriate length and style then they are not necessary.)
- White, plain shirt style blouse with school tie.
- School ties and shirts must be worn correctly, i.e. top buttons fastened, and ties knotted to the throat and of a length approximating to the waistband of the skirt/trousers of the wearer.
- Plain black socks OR black plain tights.
- Dark colour, flat shoes - NO boots or training shoes of any description are to be worn.

For PE: Black tracksuit bottoms, black shorts (no cycling shorts), white polo shirt with school logo, white socks, training shoes, grey sweatshirt with school logo (grey hooded sweatshirt with school logo new for incoming Year 7 pupils and optional for others)

Boys Uniform



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- Black blazer with school badge.
- Black jumper with school crest, NO other jumpers are permitted.
- Black or charcoal grey school trousers. (Canvas, denim etc. are not acceptable nor are 'skinny-fit' trousers. School trousers must also be worn so that the wearer's underwear is not visible.)
- White or grey shirt with school tie.
- School ties and shirts must be worn correctly, i.e. top buttons fastened, and ties knotted to the throat and of a length approximating to the waistband of the trousers of the wearer.
- Dark socks
- Dark colour sensible shoes - NO boots or trainers of any description are to be worn.

For PE: Black shorts, white polo shirts with school logo, black football socks, training shoe, grey sweatshirt with school logo (reversible black/gold hard-wearing sport shirt with school logo new for incoming Year 7 pupils and optional for others)

Non-uniform items will be taken from pupils and returned at a later time. Persistent transgressors may be withdrawn from lessons and/or receive formal detentions (notification will be sent in writing). In addition to the above uniform guidelines, parents are reminded that mobile phones are allowed in school but **MUST BE SWITCHED OFF** during lesson times. Personal music players (mp3, mp4, iPod etc.) are allowed in school (although not personal music player mobile phones) BUT are only to be used at break and lunch times. Any that are used during lessons or whilst moving between lessons will be confiscated and returned at a later time.

NB. Any valuable items brought in to school, such as mobile phones and personal music players, are done so at the pupils' own risk. School will investigate any such losses but is not liable for any loss or damage incurred and carries no insurance for such items.
