Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you to everyone in our school community for another positive week and ensuring all pupils are following the Covid guidelines in school. Thankfully I can report that we have not had any confirmed positive cases. I would like to take this opportunity to send you a couple of reminders:

1. Please ensure all pupils bring a face covering to school which must be worn at all times when moving around and in communal areas. This is for the protection of all staff and pupils in our building. Pupils are not required to wear a face covering in the classroom or on the playground.
2. Can parents/carers please check all pupils are dressed every day in full school uniform and this includes appropriate PE kit. Unfortunately we have noticed a couple of pupils are wearing tracksuits on PE day; this is unacceptable and not part of our school uniform policy. Spot checks on uniform and PE kit will be carried out on a weekly basis by the pastoral team and SLT.
3. Pupils are required to still enter and exit the school using the gate that has been allocated to their year group/bubble and must not use a gate that is used by another year group. Again this is for the safety of all in our school community. The table below states which year groups has been allocated to which gate.

Year group	Entry/ Exit point onto site
7	Visitors' car park, Stamford Road
8	Middle gate, Stamford Road
9	Bentham's Way entrance
10	Delivery gate, Stamford Road
11	Bentham's Way entrance
12/13	Delivery gate, Stamford Road

4. From Monday onwards we are resuming with a normal canteen service for all year groups, so please would parents/carers could ensure their child's ParentPay account is topped up over the weekend.

Finally, I would like to remind parents/carers of the importance of young people staying safe on the way to and from school. Everyone should avoid isolated routes and walk with others where possible. I do hope that you are all well and staying safe.
